School Uniform Policy

At St Michael's we take pride in our school and strive to ensure that high expectations are set and met. Our school uniform defines who we are as a school. It is compulsory for all students to wear the school uniform.

Below is a list of the summer and winter uniforms, as well as the expectations surrounding the sports uniform.

- Girls are permitted to wear grey slacks as an option in the winter months.
- Sun hats are compulsory school uniform during Term 1 and Term 4. Grades 1-6 wear the blue wide brim hats, whilst Foundation students wear the blue legionnaire style hat.
- Children's hair should be natural in colour, and extremes of fashion are not acceptable. The school reserves the right to determine what constitutes extremes of colour/fashion.
- For health and hygiene reasons and to assist in the prevention of head lice spreading, hair (shoulder length or longer) is to be tied back, plaited or braided. Only school colour red or blue ties/scrunchies are to be used.
- Nail polish is not to be worn at school. Jewellery is to be limited to a watch. In the interests of safety, studs are the only earrings to be worn.
